### **GREAT PRESENTATIONS!**

To kick off the 2nd National Bariatric Safe Patient Handling & Mobility (SPHM) Conference, Zsalynn Whitworth set the stage by sharing her personal experiences of obesity. Key takeaways from this presentation:

- I still have a 600-lb brain even though I have lost weight.
- Small accomplishments are important.
- Focus on safety when needing to weigh a patient.
- Avoid being judgmental.
- We (obese patients) don't always want help, but nurses seem to need to give it.
- There is a fear of the unknown "What if?"

Attendees started their 2 day journey with looking at the patient's pathway when being admitted through the ER. Captain Paul Mallon provided an eye-opening look at how the Austin EMS prepare for bariatric patient transport. Kimberly Falco and Manon Labreche then discussed meeting the needs of the bariatric patient in the ER. Attendees considered the challenges that are faced in the radiology department as Wayne Smith spoke about his experiences at Oregon Health and Science University. Yeu-Li Yeung ended the day by discussing how to be prepared for bariatric patients and how they accomplished this at Duke University Healthcare System.

The second day of the conference focused on the patient's pathway when being admitted through the OR. Sharon Van Wicklin from AORN shared her personal journey as well as the challenges faced regarding bariatric patients in the OR. Kimberly Falco built on this by discussing the needs of the bariatric patient in the ICU. Early mobility is a hot topic, and Manon Labreche presented on solutions that Tampa General Hospital has used to get bariatric patients up and moving. The final presentation of the conference centered around making the connection. Attendees discussed various case studies and the appropriate equipment and precautions to take when moving and handling bariatric patients.
